



JUNIOR EXPLORERS (SALTMINE)

Junior Explorers is for children aged 7 to 9 (i.e. those in school years 3 and 4).

We follow a theme through the term, and each week we engage in a mixture of activities on an aspect of this theme. Our sessions are based around a bible passage and a key verse to learn. Through various activities we explore the events we read about, and work to understand both what they meant then and what they mean to us today. Our sessions are varied and include games, music, drama and other creative work, as well as discussion and prayer.



SENIOR EXPLORERS (SALTMINE)



Senior explorers is an extremely lively group of 28 children in school years 5 and 6 (ages 10,11).

The aim of the group is to provide a safe place where each of the children can learn about Jesus. We do this through laughter, fun and games, together with quiet thought, reflection and prayer. We aim to teach the children about Christianity and challenge them to live out their faith in their homes, schools and with their friends.

All sessions are a mixture of games, music, dance, artwork, drama, discussion and prayer.

Saltmine is linked with another children's group - the Rainbow Club in Lima, Peru. Our children are encouraged to pray for the Rainbow Club and any money we collect is given to support their activities.
