This declaration covers the following donations made by me on or after 6th April 2003 to ST. PAUL'S CHURCH DORKING:

- All donations made by banker's order
- All donations made through the church's personalised 'Envelope Scheme'
- All (*usually one-off*) donations which are placed in an envelope marked 'Gift Aid' and which have my name written either on the envelope or somewhere inside it.

[Note: you may delete any of the above methods that you do not wish to apply]

Please treat all the donations I made by the method listed above as 'Gift Aid donations.' This means that the church will be able to reclaim tax in respect of the donations.

Note: *You must be a payer of either income tax or capital gains tax, paying tax at least equal to the amount that we reclaim on your donations.*

The amount we reclaim depends on the basic rate of income tax, with a basic rate of income tax of 22%, we reclaim about 28p for every £1 you give.

If you need any further help in understanding this requirement, please speak to an appropriate church official, such as the Planned Giving Secretary, the Treasurer or one of the Churchwardens.

Remember to notify us in future if you cease to pay the necessary amount of tax on the donations you are making.
