You can...

- Join our Planned Giving Programme
- Pray about the level of giving that is right for you and to which God is calling you for 2006 and beyond
- If possible, make your giving by Standing Order. Otherwise contributions can be made by cheque or regular offering envelopes.
- Take advantage of Gift Aid by signing a declaration form. This means that for every £1 you give, St. Paul's will get £1.28. (There are additional tax benefits for those paying tax at a higher rate. Please ask the Treasurer about this.)

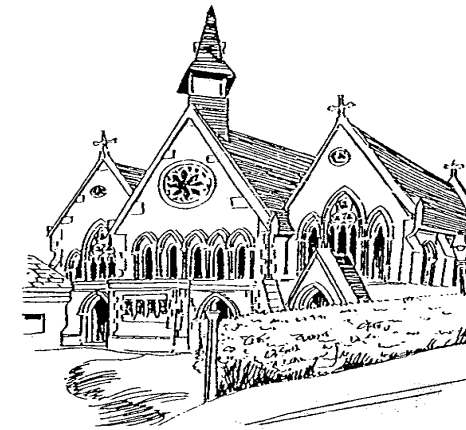

- called to mission

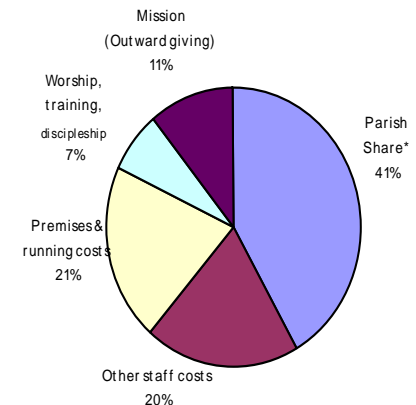
• **Current Initiatives;** staffing, pastoral care, small groups, children and youth, community outreach, mission.

● ● ● *The Funding need*

Estimates are a minimum of **£250,000** for 2006 to maintain our current ministry. In 2007 we will need more for the new initiatives we would like to develop, as well as further funds to build the proposed Church Centre.

● ● ● *Where will the money come from?*

Our target is to raise our Regular Planned Giving to **£184,200** (pre-tax recovery) from its current level of £110,000 per annum. This would mean our income would be:

Regular donations £184,200

Collections/Sundry £ 14,400

Tax recovery £ 39,400

Rent, Fees, Events £ 12,000

Total £250,000
