



## **SCRAMBLERS (SALTMINE)**

Scramblers is for children from age 3 to the end of their reception year at School. It is attended by about 10-15 children each week. There are 6 leaders who plan and lead the sessions in pairs on a rota basis.

Our aim at Scramblers is to provide a secure happy and fun environment where children can enjoy simple bible stories, play and share with new friends and learn that God loves them. Each weeks activities is based around a story and may include free-play, action games, drama, singing, a time to pray and a creative activity when the children make something to take home to their families, or to be displayed in the church or the church room. A small collection is taken each week and any money raised is sent to support the Rainbow Club in Peru.

The youngest scramblers are sometimes reluctant to attend the group so their parents are welcome to stay with them for all or part of a session until they feel confident in the group.



## **CLIMBERS (SALTMINE)**

Climbers is for children in school years 1 and 2, and our objective is to provide some biblical education whilst still maintaining the fun element of Saltmine with activities, singing and games. Most weeks we have a short time for prayer, a collection which goes to support the Rainbow club in Peru, songs, a story or play, and an activity. Children are encouraged to remember a verse from the bible relating to the teaching of the week, and have the opportunity to recite this the following week. On average we have about 18 children, and this creates a lively but manageable environment. An emphasis is made on trying to keep climbers sessions different from school, by being more informal and by having the opportunity to spend time discussing any issues raised by children.

We also try and involve the children in displaying their work in the Church during each term.
